I should explain that this post is not a general-purpose review of photo editing software of any kind; those reviews will be posted separately. Instead, I'm talking about something that I use for a particular task: cropped photos. Since I am a professional photographer, I use Photoshop for most of my fine-tuning, but I still need to crop every single picture that I shoot. On Windows, I use Snipping Tool for cropping.

You can now add a comment on a photo or video using the comment tool at the bottom of the Files panel.
